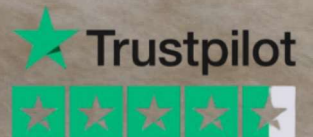

For families, local authorities and housing providers adapting existing homes is often more desirable, practical and cost-effective than relocation.

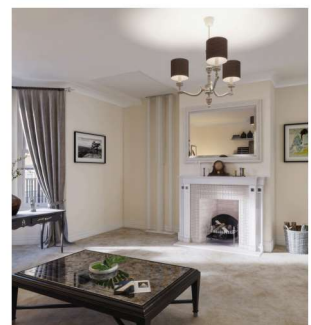

A lift that is designed for safety and comfort

At Wessex Lifts safety is not an afterthought—it is engineered into every detail.

Fire protection, structural integrity and operational safety are fully integrated, meeting the requirements of BS5900:2012, the Machinery Directive, and UKCA and CE compliance.

In the event of a power failure, the lift is equipped with a battery backup and manual lowering system, safely returning the user to the ground floor. Controls are accessible both inside and outside the car, ensuring that even lone occupants can operate the lift with confidence.

Additionally, the VE enclosed Car Home Lift has a fully tested and comprehensive safety system including sensitive edges around the top, bottom and around the car to ensure that in the event of an obstruction the lift will automatically stop, ensuring the safety of the passenger, others in the house or pets.

Key Safety & Performance Features:

- 250kg - 300kg load capacity as standard (model dependent)
- Certified to BS5900:2012, UKCA & CE and EU Machinery Directive
- Pressure-sensitive safety surfaces that immediately stop the lift if an obstruction is detected above or below
- Fire-sealed aperture between floors, maintaining 30 minute structural fire integrity
- Battery backup & manual lowering for safe operation during power loss
- Intuitive controls accessible from inside and outside the lift

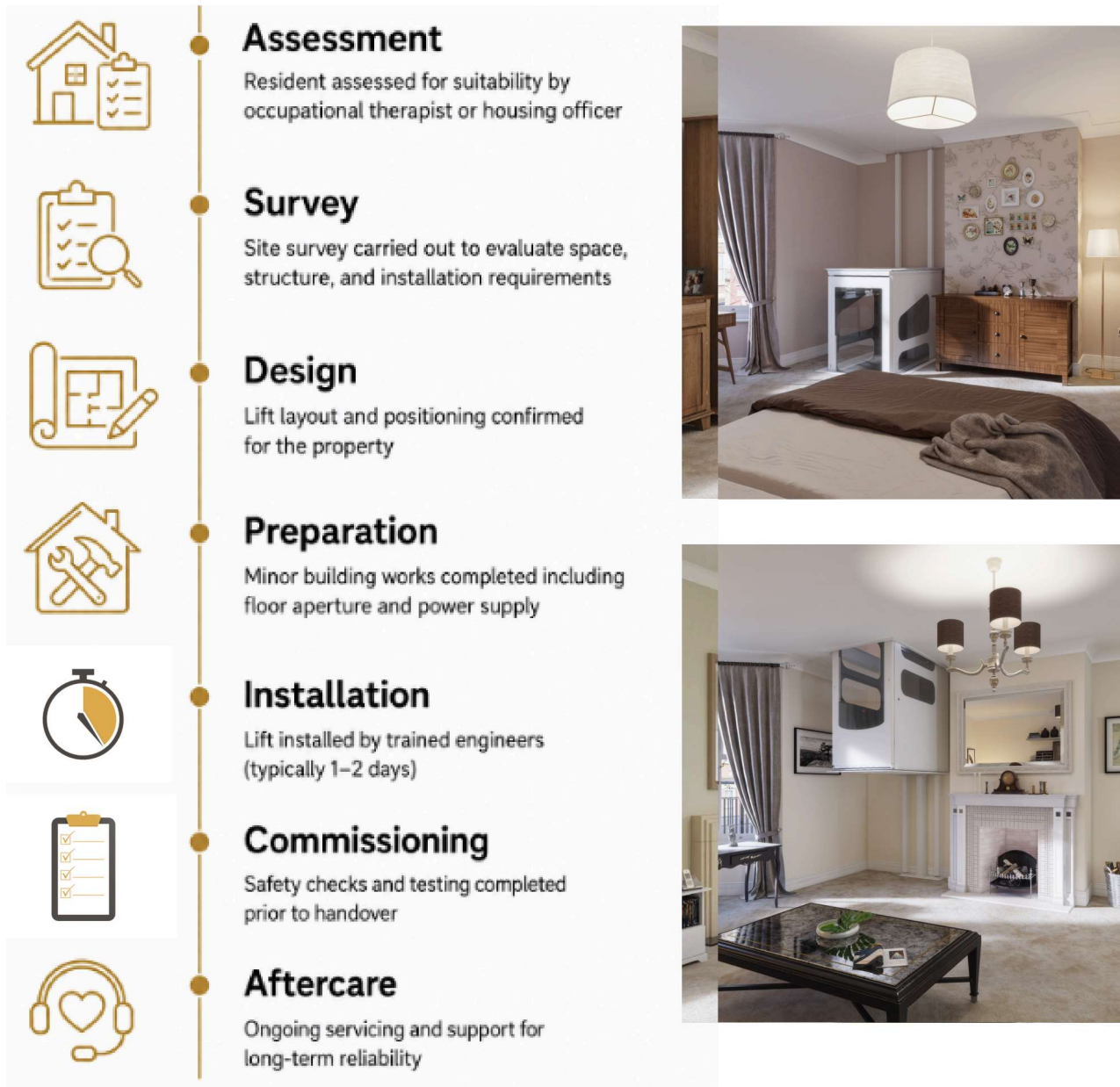


1. Low entry ramp 2. In car controls 3. Remote handset/call station

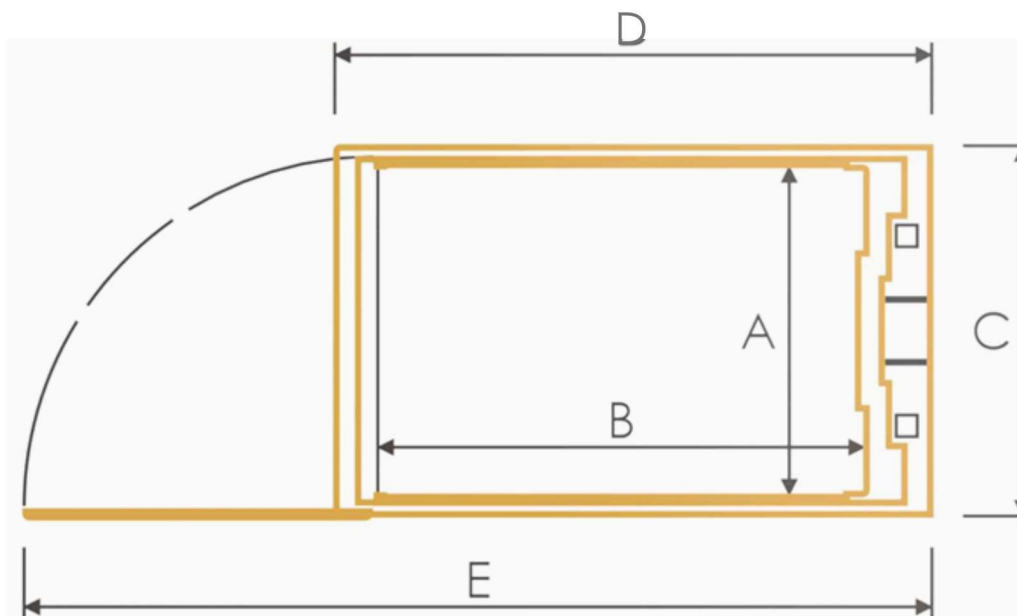
